- a team player with proven leadership skills, able to lead, manage and motivate people in the church at all levels, with an optimistic attitude and openness to God's leading
- a person with a heart and ability to encourage and support the spiritual growth of all members of the church
- a person who has the spiritual qualities to be an elder of the church as taught in the Bible
- an effective and confident communicator, who is also able to represent the church outside of the church.

While not essential, it would be helpful if the person had theological training.
